GOALS & OBJECTIVES:

The main goal of the program is to implement hands-on teaching skills, which will bring about the desired changes in behavior and attitude of the participants through the concept of accountability, efficiency, and personal change of behavior. The program plans to foster this behavior through EDUCATING, ENLIGHTENING, AND ENHANCING. The program stimulates students' social, physical, and intellectual abilities through participation with their school peers.

REGISTRATION & ENROLLMENT:

Each year Kingdom Kids Preparatory School will continue to offer the Summer Explosion program, provided the minimum number of students register, and a sufficient number of instructors are available. **Parents must complete and sign a registration form every year.** After the initial open enrollment period, registration will be ended unless the program can adequately serve additional students. If classes are full, parents may have their children placed on a waiting list. Parents will be notified when/if space becomes available.

Children who are enrolled in the Summer Explosion program, but are removed from the program for any reason (voluntary, disciplinary, late fee payment, etc.); will not be guaranteed re-enrollment in the program and no refunds will be given.

BUILDING ENTRANCE:

All students will enter the building for Summer Explosion on the Hunter Street side of the Building of Opportunity double doors. All children must be signed in/out. Sign in/out forms will be located at the entrance of the building on the Hunter Street side. Due to COVID-19 no one is allowed passed the door, except the child and the teacher. Parents and any other guests are not allowed in the classrooms.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE:

(Please read Release of Children on page 11)

Each student must be signed in at drop off and signed out at pick up. Please do not drop kids off at the front entrance. All students must enter through the Hunter Street side of the Beulah Grove Building of Opportunity double doors.

TUITION:

REGISTRATION FEE:	\$50 non-refundable (per child)
ACTIVITY FEE:	\$100 non-refundable (per child)
WEEKLY FEE:	\$85/ week per child

****Registration fee, week one, and activity fees are due by May 25, 2023**** Tuition payment of \$85.00 per week is paid on a weekly or bi-weekly, basis. **Parents must pay the \$ 85.00 per week fee per child (unless discount applied) by the Thursday before the week of participation.** If the program is closed on Thursday, payment will be due on the date designated by Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Administration. Tuition is paid by cash, debit, credit, cash app, and /or money order.

Please note there will be <u>NO REFUNDS</u>

Space is limited and parents are encouraged to apply early in order to secure a slot for your child. <u>The first week's tuition and registration fee is due at the time of registration until May 25, 2023.</u>

NO CHECKS are accepted

Payments can be made with: cash, money orders, debit, or credit cards. Cash App can be utilized after student has been registered.

No refunds of any kind will be given. This rule applies whether tuition is paid in full or weekly. No exceptions.

TUITION SCHEDULE:

Tuition is due on Thursday of each week. Your child/children will not be allowed to attend classes or activities if tuition is not received by the due date.

Registration fee is due at submission of paperwork, activity fee and first week's tuition are due May 25, 2023, in full. The registration fee will not reserve or hold any classroom slots. **No refunds** of any kind will be given.

NOTE: ANY PARENT WHO HAS A CHILD THAT HAS BEEN PARTICIPATING IN ANY OF THE KINGDOM KIDS PREPARATORY SCHOOL PROGRAMS (I.E. DEVELOPMENT CENTER, CHRISTIAN ACADEMY, ALPHA AND OMEGA, ETC.), WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER IF THERE IS AN OUTSTANDING BALANCE FOR SERVICES RENDERED.

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If your child/children will not be attending the entire program (For example: only weeks 3 & 5), **Full** payment for the weeks attending must be paid upon registration. *Any changes to this policy must be made a minimum 5 days prior to the scheduled week of attendance.* **No Refunds** will be given.

No Refunds will be given if your child has been dismissed from the program due to behavioral problems. Please review the disciplinary policy. No Refunds of any kind will be given.

LATE PAYMENTS OF TUITION:

Payments are due by 6:00 p.m. on Thursday for the upcoming week. Failure to pay by this time will result in a \$10.00 late fee. The **<u>\$10.00 late fee</u>** will be assessed to all accounts paid after 6:00 p.m. on Thursdays.

If a parent has any outstanding financial obligations to the Summer Explosion Program that is not satisfactorily cleared within a 2-day period, the child/children will not be allowed to continue to participate in the program until the obligation is <u>completely</u> resolved.

LATE PICK UP FEES:

All students must be picked up by 6:00 pm. A \$1.00 per minute fee will be assessed starting at 6:01 pm. <u>All late fees will be attached to your bill and if not paid within three(3) days the student will not be allowed to return to the program until the late fee payment is made in full and the account is cleared by the Accounting Clerk.</u>

ATTIRE:

Students may wear casual sportswear. No ripped or patched clothing is permitted. For safety reasons, **flip flops are not to be worn.**

We ask that clothes be appropriate and in good taste (no sexually provocative clothing, no profanity, or racial slurs.) Please keep in mind that this is a family camp.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of the parents, and they are reminded to pick up their children by 6:00 pm each day or a late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be added to the account.

RELEASE OF CHILDREN:

At the end of the day children will be released **only** to persons who are authorized to pick them up as indicated on the registration form. If someone other than the authorized persons will pick up a child, **prior written permission** is required stating the name and telephone number of the person who will pick up the child, including those authorized on the application. Anyone picking up a child may be required to show pictured identification.

If no one comes to pick up the child from the program by 6:00 pm parents will be contacted. If parents cannot be reached, other authorized persons listed on the registration form will be called. If no one can be reached to pick up the child by 6:30 pm, the program will call 911 for a police officer to pick up the child from the program.

Early pickup is permissible by signing out the student. All students must be signed out prior to leaving the class. **Parents are not allowed to go to the classrooms.** If someone other than the parent or legal guardian listed will pick up a child, **prior written permission** is required stating the name and telephone number of the person who will pick up the child, including those authorized on the application. Anyone picking up a child may be required to show pictured identification. All pickups must enter through the Hunter Street side of the Building of Opportunity double doors. A child will not be released without proper identification or proper approval. (See Appendix A)

CLASS DIVISIONS:

Students are to be divided according to appropriate grade levels and with regard to the number of participants at the program.

EXAMPLES OF ACTIVITIES: (Appendix C)

FINALE/ENDING PROGRAM:

The finale for the Summer Explosion Program will be on Thursday, July 11, 2024. The program will commence at 9:00 am sharp. All parents/guest are invited to attend. The finale will be held in the dining hall of the Building of Opportunity or the Main Sanctuary.

Summer Explosion will end with a trip to a destination chosen by the administration of Summer Explosion. The trip will be taken on Friday, July 12, 2024, on charter buses. Any child attending Summer Explosion that paid the Activity Fee in full...is automatically included in the major field trip. The major field trip is a determination made by Summer Explosion Leadership and will be communicated if such a decision in made two-three weeks prior to the closing event. A parent or guardian must attend the major field trip. Parents are responsible for feeding child/ren during the trip. Parents are responsible for feeding child/ren during the trip. MEDICAL:

In order for medicine to be dispersed the parent/guardian of this child, must have completed and signed the medical information sheet (See Appendix B). The Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion is in no way liable for any injuries that may occur to a student. Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion will only dispense prescribed medications by a physician for children.

Health and Safety:

Children who are too ill to participate in the activities of the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion should remain in the comfort of their own home. If, during the day, the teacher feels your child is too ill to remain at Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion, you will be called to pick up the child.

Your child should be treated for symptoms (i.e., fever, vomiting, diarrhea, etc.) and should remain at home for 24 hours before returning to Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion. A physician should diagnose a suspicious rash or eye irritation before bringing your child to the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion. Your cooperation with this policy will hopefully reduce contagious illnesses within Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion.

A current emergency form is kept for each child that includes the following information: medical concerns, emergency phone numbers, and permission for your child to be treated in case of an emergency. Please be sure to update this information as necessary. If your child requires prescription medication during the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion, you must inform the administrative team of Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion. Children are not allowed to medicate themselves. Emergency plans for severe weather, fire, and physical plant problems have been developed and are posted for your viewing.

Safety will be given first consideration in all circumstances. Staff is present in the classroom and /or playground for arrivals and departures of all children. No child will be allowed to leave the building unless accompanied by an adult. Parents are responsible for their child until they have placed them in the supervision of Kingdom Kid Summer Explosion Staff and when they have removed him/her from Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion.

Minor injuries will be addressed by the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Administration or someone knowledgeable in first aid. If medical attention is needed, **911** will be called for assistance and parents will be notified immediately if **911** is called. Parents will be informed of all minor injuries.

If a student must be transported to the hospital, parent/guardian will be notified immediately, and a representative of King Kids Summer Explosion Administrative team will accompany the student.

Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion will have the ambulance to take the child to Children's Hospital of Georgia, located at 1446 Harper Str., Augusta, GA 30912

BREAKFAST/LUNCH:

Breakfast and a hot lunch will be provided daily by the staff of Kingdom Kids Preparatory School. A weekly menu will be provided. Students are allowed to bring their own lunch.

SNACKS:

Light snacks will be provided in the afternoon daily. Snack examples include: Cracker/Cookies Ice Cream Milk or Juice Popcorn Fruit Chips

PERSONAL ARTICLES:

Students should not bring toys, trading cards, sporting equipment, money, cell phones, valuable items, or pets to the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion. If a student brings items neither Kingdom Kids Preparatory School, Beulah Grove, nor Summer Explosion will be responsible for lost, stolen, traded, or damage items.

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

Regular school discipline policies are in effect for the Summer Explosion Program. However, if a student is disruptive or threatens other students in any way, it may affect his or her future participation in the Program. Discipline problems will be handled using the following guidelines:

1 st Offense:	Administrator counsels the Student

Depending on the severity of the offense, immediate dismissal from the program is a possibility. Parents will be notified immediately of this situation.
